



SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM POLICIES

At R.E.V.A.M.P., we commit to creating an environment that is safe and enjoyable for every camper. Our programming and policies are geared to drive our mission to empower and enlighten our youth, while ensuring that parents, students and staff are in understanding and are working together accordingly.

PAYMENT POLICIES

An application must be submitted for each child. The cost of camp is \$250 per child for the full 7 themed weeks. A multi-camper discount of \$195 per child is given after full price of the first child within the same household. The full payment is due at the time of registration. 50% is refundable if you unenroll your child from the program prior to the start date. 25% is refundable after Day 1 of camp begins.

DROP OFF/PICK UP INFORMATION

Parents/guardians are required to sign children in and out each day. There will be no supervision on site prior to start time or after the program ends. It is required that children are signed in and picked up **on time** from the program during designated hours. **Only registered children may attend.** Parents/Guardians will be granted a 5 min grace period for end of the day pickup. After 5 mins a \$1/min late fee will be charged to parents, due before child(ren) start their next day of camp.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS & SPECIAL NEEDS

Children **may not** attend or participate in the R.E.V.A.M.P. program prior to returning a completed and signed application form containing Emergency Contact information. It is imperative that you notify program staff of any special issues or challenges your child may face so that we can ensure the safety and well-being of your child, as well as create a rewarding experience. A confidentiality policy is followed by all staff and instructors, so your privacy will be protected. Also note the staff and instructors cannot dispense medication to your child. If your child has medical needs, please plan to provide whatever care is required during program hours.

ATTENDANCE & ILLNESS

We expect all paid campers to be at the program every day unless ill. If your student will be late

or absent, please alert the front office by emailing bpyouthhopeww@bridgepointe.life so that staff can plan the day accordingly. If your child is ill, contagious and/or running a fever, please **DO NOT** bring or allow him/her to attend the program.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Campers are required to follow all rules, guidelines & Code of Conduct in the student handbook of their attended school and Marietta City Schools. The Code of Conduct has been prepared to help your child experience a successful enjoyable time at the R.E.V.A.M.P. and yield consistency in expected behaviors from your child while in camp and school. Please take the time to read over the Code of Conduct carefully and go over them with your son/daughter. Parents should promote cooperation and agreement between the home and the program. It is expected that each and every one participating demonstrate appropriate behavior. The R.E.V.A.M.P. staff are in charge and have the authority to make the decisions pertaining to inappropriate behavior. Discipline at the program will be administered with firmness, fairness and consistency.

In all cases the following consequences will happen:

Violation #1--Each incident will be written up and kept on file and a warning will be given.

Violation #2--The student will be written up and participant will be asked to leave for the rest of the day.

Violation #3--Depending on the severity of the violation the participant maybe suspended for a period of time appropriate to the violation. The suspension will be determined by the Program Director. Also, parent/guardian will be contacted.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Please provide your child with a backpack to keep all their belongings organized and safe. Be mindful of the clothing and belongings of your child as R.E.V.A.M.P. and staff are not responsible if your child's clothes become messy or ruined during activities or if any belongings are misplaced, lost or stolen.

FOOD AT CAMP

Parents/Guardians are responsible for all food periods (breakfast, lunch, snack) during camp. R.E.V.A.M.P. will have pizza for lunch and light snacks available for sell each day. If meals or adequate funds to purchase food is not sent with child, parents/guardians will be penalized the cost of feeding the child(ren) and an additional inconvenience fee of \$15 per penalty, due prior to child's next day of camp. Please be sure to list all food allergies on the application form and discuss with program staff.
